**Psalm 127:1**

<sup>1</sup>Unless the LORD builds the house, its builders labor in vain.

**1 Kings 6:2**

<sup>2</sup>The temple that King Solomon built for the LORD was sixty cubits long, twenty wide and thirty high.

**1 Kings 6:21-22**

<sup>21</sup>Solomon covered the inside of the temple with pure gold, and he extended gold chains across the front of the inner sanctuary, which was overlaid with gold. <sup>22</sup>So he overlaid the whole interior with gold. He also overlaid with gold the altar that belonged to the inner sanctuary.

**1 Kings 6:38-7:2**

<sup>38</sup>In the eleventh year in the month of Bul, the eighth month, the temple was finished in all its details according to its specifications. Solomon had spent seven years building it. <sup>1</sup>It took Solomon thirteen years, however, to complete the construction of his palace. <sup>2</sup>He built the Palace of the Forest of Lebanon a hundred cubits long, fifty wide and thirty high, with four rows of cedar columns supporting trimmed cedar beams.

**Mark 13:1-2**

<sup>1</sup>“Look, Teacher! What massive stones! What magnificent buildings!” <sup>2</sup>“Do you see all these great buildings?” replied Jesus. “Not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down.”

**Amos 9:6**
